
What kind of people attract you most?

The RIASEC Theory, by John L. Holland, cited by Richard Bolles in 'What Color is Your Parachute?' (Ten Speed Press, 1993)


Imagine you have been invited to 6 different parties all at the same time.

Put your first, second and third choice party letter in these boxes




