


**What does God

I wonder.....

- How I should make sense of my faith as a whole?
- What it is that God keeps niggling me to do?
- What is my purpose and how best to live it out in daily life?
- How best to live out my vocation in the world

Will this course help me?



This course offers:

- A way of thinking through vocation in the widest sense of the word
- The means to explore how the idea of 'vocation' is for everyone
- The chance to work with a group of like-minded individuals to think these questions through together
- A focus on not just doing 'churchy' things. It is about affirming your whole life and your work in the world
- A way of putting faith, work and life back together
- An opportunity to think about vocation as more than just a job

The course has 5 elements:

1. Introduction to Vocation

This session explores what vocation means for everyone and looks at examples of vocation in the Bible.

2. My Core Purpose

This session explores our core purpose as human beings and who we are uniquely made to be.

3. Call to Attend

This session explores what God may be calling us to attend to in the world as part of his mission of love to the world.

4. Identifying Our Mission

This session helps to clarify our own sense of mission and the actions that we are being called to take in response to it.

5. Supporting Each Other

This session explores how as a church community we can support and encourage each other in exercising our vocations.

There is a small amount of preparation needed before each session.
